

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do I have to have a roommate to register for the trip?

A: No, a limited number of single rooms are available for an additional premium if that is your preference. There may also be another traveler looking for a roommate if your preference is for double occupancy.

Q: When is the reservation deadline?

A: The new base cost of \$3198 is valid until October 19, 2017.

Q: When is final payment due?

A: The initial deposit is \$1800. Final payment is due by October 20, 2017.

Q: Will I need a passport?

A: Yes, and it must be valid at least until July 13, 2018. Please note that names on registration forms must be an exact match to passports.

Q: Will USA or Canadian citizens need a travel visa or special vaccination?

A: No.

Q: Are there any additional expenses not included in the \$3198 price for the trip?

A: This price is based on double occupancy. It is an all-inclusive cost with the exception of optional travel insurance, baggage fees and meals at the airport, daily lunch (\$10-\$18 per day depending on your preferences), and a love offering for the bus driver and tour guide.

Q: Are single rooms available?

A: Yes, there are a limited number of single rooms. The single supplement is an additional \$498.

Q: What currency will we use during the trip?

A: The US dollar is legal tender. It will not be necessary to convert to any other currency.

Q: What's the weather like?

A: January is typically their coolest month of the year with an average high of 65°F and an average low of 48°F. Because of elevation, it is warmer in Tel Aviv and Tiberias, and colder in Jerusalem. There is relatively low humidity. Be prepared for rain.

Q: How about travel insurance?

A: The premium rate begins at \$349 per person and is based on the cost of your trip.

Q: Do I have to be Moravian to participate?

A: No, everyone is welcome.

Q: May I use a credit card to pay for the trip?

A: Educational Opportunities Tours will add a 4% service charge to the cost of the trip.
